- 1.Create a Treasure hunt for someone in your family to follow. One clue should lead to another and another. ex. You will find your first clue in the place where you brush your teeth. Then, at your bathroom sink there would be another clue leading somewhere else. Try to do at least 6 clues. ©
- 2. Write a story about the Mystery of the Disappearing Easter Chocolate. I want you to think about who stole the chocolate and why did they do it. How do you get it back?
- 3. Write a letter to the Easter Bunny and leave it for him to find.
- 4.Make a list of grocery items that you will need for your house. You get to choose the items, but you must choose 15 items!! Then I want you to calculate how much your grocery list is going to cost you. Will \$120 be enough for your list? If not how much more do you need? If it is enough, how much money do you have left?
- 5.Write and solve 3 addition word problems and 3 subtraction word problems. They should be Easter themed and they should be creative! Remember to challenge yourself with the numbers you choose!!
- 6.Try to create an Easter basket that will hold an object (about egg sized), using only newspaper... nothing else!! Be creative and have fun with this.
- 7.Draw an outdoor spring scene and hide 10 decorated eggs in the scene. Once complete (coloured and all) see if your family can find all the hidden eggs.

Finally I would like you to continue to read each day for 30 minutes and get lots of exercise and fresh air!!
